CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATION OF ARC, LLC AND VLIET HOLDINGS, LLC SEEKING TO CONVERT 825 24TH STREET, WATERVLIET, NEW YORK (FORMER SCHOOL 9) INTO A 17-UNIT APARTMENT BUILDING

Dan Hershenberg, 18 Locust Street, Albany, New York, spoke on behalf of the application. He explained the applicant would like to convert the property into 17 apartments which would include 10 parking spaces (7 on vacant lot across the street and 3 on side of street). The project would require 26 parking spaces according to the City of Watervliet's Zoning Code. The developer is out of Connecticut and has done work on Washington Avenue in Albany and Erie Boulevard in Schenectady. They have the finances for the project and the contractors. They would need to be approved for 17 apartments to make the project feasible and affordable. They would hire a management company with 24/7 property maintenance and a leasing agent. The floors would be rehabbed where possible but would be hardwood. Each apartment would have a washer/dryer, separate electric per apartment, sprinkler system. There was a discussion regarding the sewer line and whether it was equipped to handle 17 apartments. Attendees spoke in favor and against the application. The worry for neighborhood residents was the parking.

The application was tabled to allow applicant to further investigate additional parking possibilities.
